inventor - a person who creates new devices, technologies, etc.

Example: Intellectual property rights allow inventors to protect their ideas.

portable - that can be easily moved from one place to another

Example: My computer is light and portable.

pave the way - to create the appropriate conditions for something to appear or happen

Example: Henry Ford's innovations paved the way for the modern automobile.

set the tone - to establish a particular mood or environment for something

Example: They turned off the lights to set the tone for the ceremony.
