Vocabulary:

Non-judgmental (adjective) – avoiding moral judgments; not quick to criticize people

Example: A good friend is nonjudgmental.

instill (verb)

– to gradually make somebody feel, think or behave in a particular way over a period of time

Example: My high-school teacher instilled a love of history in me.

flop down (idiom)

– to sit or lie down in a heavy way by relaxing your muscles and letting your body fall

Example: My brother flopped down next to me on the beach.

snuggle up to (phrasal verb)

– to lie down near someone or something; to press close to someone or something

Example: The kitten snuggled up to its mother.
