**tease** (verb): make fun of

**Example:** Some of the kids in my class are always teasing my sister, and I can't get them to stop.

**nasty** (adjective): terrible

**Example:** I can't believe kids post such nasty messages on Facebook.

**principal** (noun): manager or director of a school

**Example:** The principal spoke to all of the kids at school about the problems of cyberbullying.

**anxious** (adjective): nervous

**Example:** Brittany feels very anxious about going to school these days.

**improve** (verb): make better

**Example:** If you want to improve the environment for kids at school, you have to speak out about the problems of bullying.
