Vocabulary:

binge (noun)

– a short period of time when somebody does too much of a particular activity, especially eating or drinking alcohol

Example: College students are more prone to binge drinking than other social categories.

impairment (noun)

– the state of having a physical or mental condition in which a part of your body or brain does not work correctly

Example: This new surgery can do wonders in almost any case of vision impairment.

don (verb)

– to put on a piece of clothing or hats

Example: A hunter will don his camouflage clothes when he goes hunting.

tremor (noun)

– a slight shaking movement in a part of your body caused, for example, by cold or fear

Example: She described the accident with a tremor in her voice.

manuever (verb) = move skillfully or carefully

Example: I maneuvered the car into the space.
