

marry/get married/be married

A lot of people get confused about how to use these words. Maybe this will help.



to marry (someone)- this is the general verb. It is the time when people come together as husband and wife.

- Do not say *I married with someone*. It is not correct.
- And do not say *I married to someone*. It is also incorrect.
- Correct example: *I married Sam 3 years ago*.

to get married- this talks about the time two people got married. It makes us think of the wedding.

- Correct example: *I got married*.

to get married to (someone)- We think of who was married in the wedding.

- Do not say *I got married with someone*. It is incorrect.
- Correct example: *I got married to Sam*.

to get married in (someplace)- We think of where the wedding took place.

- Correct Example: *I got married in Hawaii*.
