**improve** (verb): make something better **Example**: A haircut could improve your looks.

**sign up** (verb): put or write your name on a list to join something **Example**: Are you going to sign up for math class this semester?

identity (noun): the name of a person, who you are

**Example:** You can protect your identity better by not sharing your birthday and mailing address online.

fishy (adjective): untrue or dishonest

**Example:** Be careful. This advertisement looks a little fishy. I mean, how can this company give you a free vacation to Hawaii just for testing their products?

secure (adjective): safe, protected from danger

**Example:** Please make sure the house is secure before you leave today.

gullible (adjective): easily fooled, tricked, or cheated

**Example:** You are so gullible. I can't believe you bought on the Internet without seeing it first or getting the real name of the seller.
