Outlines



An **outline** is a general plan of what you are going to write in the finished paper. It will show the order of your information, what each paragraph will discuss, etc. The first thing you might want to do is to make a list of the things that you will need to write about in your paper. Then see if these items can be grouped together so that they seem to make sense in a few paragraphs.

Writing an outline is also a great remedy to writer's block, as it allows you to express your ideas briefly without getting unduly bogged down in the details or in correct grammar or word choice too early on in the writing process.
