Thesis Statement – Compare and Contrast

The **thesis statement** is that sentence or two in your text that **contains the focus of your essay and tells your reader what the essay is going to be about.** Although it is certainly possible to write a good essay without a thesis statement the lack of a thesis statement may well be a symptom of an essay beset by a lack of focus.

A **comparison** is the **process of showing how things are alike;**

! **contrast** is the **process of showing differences.**

In comparing and contrasting ideas we use conjunctions.

To **compare** the ideas if they are similar in some way. Here are some words.

like	similar to	also	as	in the same way
and	similarly	likewise	agree
