A paraphrase is...

- You use your own words to express what another person wrote or said.
- When you paraphrase a sentence or group of sentences, look for the most important points.

POINTS TO REMEMBER IN PARAPHRASING

- Always use your own words and your own sentence structure.
- Write in a style that is natural to you.
- ***o not** change the essential nature of what the writer is saying - it is the writer's point of view that you are writing about.

Although you need not put quotation marks around a paraphrased passage, you **ust** give a citation in the appropriate form.
