Academic writing is the type of writing students are expected to produce in response to content they learn about in an academic setting; i.e. school. The standard for good academic writing is how logical or reasonable the writer's thinking is — is the author's opinion based in evidence that is credible and convincing? As such, academic writing is a window into one's intellectual life—and that's why it's such an important skill to focus on. Not only does writing show us what a child is thinking; but the process of writing helps develop your child's thinking.
