Do you know which preposition to use before times, days, month and years?

When is your birthday?

Mine is **on** October 12.

When do you eat lunch?

I usually eat lunch **at** noon.

When does the school year begin in your country?

In my country, it begins **in** September.



Don't forget to use...

In + month or year

- In March
- In 2003

On + date (with the year or without the year), or day of the week

- On January 12
- On January 12, 2016
- On Monday

At + clock time, midnight, noon

- At 4:30a.m.
- At 14:00
- At noon
