Vocabulary:

loophole (noun)

– something that has been left out of a law or legal document that people can use to avoid obeying it

Example: He used a legal loophole to convince the judge that he was innocent.

rhetoric (noun)

– speech or writing that is intended to influence people, but that is not completely honest or sincere

Example: The politician's rhetoric on immigration is very troubling.

displace (verb)

– take over the place, position, or role of someone or something

Example: She thinks that in the future many people will lose their jobs and will be displaced by robots.

catapult (verb)

– (figurative) to cause (someone or something) to quickly move up or ahead or to a better position

Example: Her outstanding performance in the play catapulted her to stardom.

There is growing concern that India's \$150 billion information technology industry, which relies heavily on exports to the United States, could slow and become less competitive if the Trump administration tightens rules on hiring skilled foreign workers.

Sponsors of the bill say it is designed to close loopholes in the high-skilled immigration system being used by some companies to import cheap foreign workers.
