

Learning Styles



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Reading

Traditionally, schools present information in two ways through language and through formulae involving numbers and logic. Psychologists, however, now say there's a problem with this. People have different strengths and different learning styles to match these strengths. For example, one person might struggle with information in a paragraph but understand it immediately in a diagram. Another person will struggle with the diagram but not with the paragraph.

Psychologist Howard Gardner of Harvard University has said there are at least seven learning styles:

Linguistic

These people will learn by using language ? listening, reading, speaking, and writing.

Logical

These people learn by applying mathematical formulas and scientific principles.
