Vocabulary:

inherently (adverb)

– according to or because of the basic nature of somebody/something

Example: Wolves are inherently aggressive.

pursue (a career) (phrase)

– to do something or try to achieve something over a period of time

Example: I want to pursue a career in advertising.

stereotype (noun)

– a fixed idea or image that many people have of a particular type of person or thing, but which is often not true in reality

Example: It is just a stereotype that men can't cook.

endorse (verb)

– to make a public statement of your approval or support for something or someone

Example: The rock star agreed to endorse their product on TV.

perception (noun)

– an idea, a belief or an image you have as a result of how you see or understand something

Example: His perception of happiness is completely different from mine.

shy away (phrasal verb)

– to avoid something that you dislike, fear, or do not feel confident about

Example: His grandfather has never shied away from manual labor.
