Preposition of Time (in , on , at)

→ tell us when things happen.

Types of Personal Pronoun

1. at

→ use for things that happen at a set time.

e.g

a. Sunrise is **at** five a.m.

b. I eat lunch **at** one p.m.

2. on

→ for things that happen on set dates or days.

e.g

a. New Year's day is celebrated on January 1.

b. Filipino people celebrate Independence day on June 12.

Please give me an example using on:

3. in

→ when talking about the things that happen within a month or a year.

→ things that happen within a month or a year.

e.g

a. I came in U.K **in** 2001.

b. My birthday is **in** September.
