Pronouns

- a word that is used instead of a **noun** or a **noun** phrase
- are often used to refer to a noun that has already been mentioned.

I. PERSONAL PRONOUN

- refers to some specific person, place, or thing.

Types of Personal Pronoun

1. First Person pronoun

- refers to the person speaking.

e.g I, We

- I saw an elephant.
- We have bought a new house.

2. Second Person Pronoun

- refers to the person spoken to.

e.g **you**

- Do **you** have a pencil?

Please give me an examples using second person pronoun.

3. Third Person Pronoun

- refers to the person or thing(people or things) spoken about.

e.g **He, She, It, They**

- Scott is a good boy.
He is a good boy.
- Jenny is goping to the kitchen. **She** is going to get some water.
- The bag is big and **it** is color yellow.
- They** are playing soccer.
