

Pronunciation of -S, -ES:

1. To make a noun plural, a final -s or -es is added to the noun:

> **Noun + s**

e.g. friend → friends

> **Noun + es**

e.g. glass → glasses

2. A final -s or -es is added to a present tense verb when the subject is a singular noun,

e.g. my father works at a bank. (My father is a singular noun)

> **Verb + s**

e.g. work → works

> **Verb + es**

e.g. watch → watches

Spelling: Final -s / -es

•Most words (verbs & nouns), add a final -s,

e.g. sing → sings;

song → songs
