

Philippine President's Next Campaign: Public Smoking Ban

Vocabulary:

hearing (noun)

– an official meeting at which the facts about a crime, complaint, etc. are presented to the person or group of people who will have to decide what action to take

Example: He will face a disciplinary hearing because of his actions.

ordinance (noun)

– an order or a rule made by a government or somebody in a position of authority

Example: The ordinance states that all budget requests will be forwarded to the department heads.

linger (verb)

– to continue to exist for longer than expected

Example: The memory of that meeting lingered in the back of my mind for a long time.

crackdown (noun)

– severe action taken to restrict the activities of criminals or of people opposed to the government or somebody in authority

Example: The government ordered a crackdown on crime.

revelry (noun)

– noisy fun, usually involving a lot of eating and drinking

Example: I always find it hard to recover from the New Year's revelries.
