**Example:** Be sure to clean off any specks of dust off your camera lens before you take pictures. Otherwise, they won't turn out well.

beside the point: not important or relevant

**Example:** I know my phone is six years old, and the camera is broken on it. That's beside the point. It still works, so I don't need to buy a new one.
