Vocabulary:

swelter (verb)

– to be very hot in a way that makes you feel uncomfortable

Example: We sweltered on the way here because the bus didn't have an air conditioning system.

forecaster (noun)

– a person who says what is expected to happen, especially somebody whose job is to forecast the weather

Example: The weather forecaster at my favorite TV station retired after 25 years on the job.

breeze (noun)

– a light wind

Example: There is a cool breeze in the air today.

cope with (verb)

– to deal successfully with something difficult

Example: I am having trouble coping with work stress.

substantially (adverb)

– very much; a lot

Example: Brand recognition has improved substantially because of this campaign.
