**next to** [nekst tə]  
**opposite** [ˈɒpəzɪt]  
**corner** [ˈkɔːnə]

Who is sitting next to you? *Jill is sitting next to me.*

How many corners does a square have? *A square has four corners.*

Are you sitting in the corner of the room? *Yes, I'm sitting in the corner of the room.*  
*or: No, I'm not sitting in the corner of ...*

What's next to this school? *There's a church next to this school.*

What's opposite this building? *There's a bus stop opposite this building.*

What's on the corner of the street? *There's a bank on the corner of the street.*

**bring** [brɪŋ]  
**take** [teɪk]

*We come here but we go there.*

*When we bring something, it means we come here with something.*

*When we take something, it means we go there with something.*

What time do you come to the lesson? *I come to the lesson at five o'clock.*

What time do you go home after the lesson? *I go home after the lesson at seven o'clock.*

What do you always bring to the lesson? *I always bring my pen and my book to the lesson.*

Do you ever forget to bring your book to school? *Yes, I sometimes forget to bring my book to school.*

*or: No, I never forget to bring ... ▶▶▶*
