Vocabulary:

acronym (noun)

– a word formed from the first letters of the words that make up the name of something

Example: AIDS is the acronym of the disease called acquired immune deficiency syndrome.

coalition (noun)

– the act of two or more groups joining together

Example: The political coalition formed by the three parties has a majority in the Parliament.

inherent (adjective)

– that is a basic or permanent part of somebody/something and that cannot be removed

Example: The project failed because of an inherent flaw in the design.

cessation (noun)

– the stopping of something; a pause in something

Example: The cessation of the aid program could have devastating consequences.
