

Wind from Trains Produces Electricity

VOCABULARY:

whooshing (adjective)– having a rushing sound produced when strong wind or water passes

*Example: The plane made a **whooshing** sound as it took off.*

convert (verb)– to change something into a different form or feature

*Example: The banker **converted** my dollar bills to yen.*

install (verb)– to put or attach in a certain position to be ready for usage

*Example: A cable needs to be **installed** before the computer can be used.*

remote (adjective)– extremely far away; separated from the main area

*Example: **Remote** villages in some countries do not have electricity.*

Additional Info: **Remote** is also used as a noun to refer to “a device that is used to control a machine from a certain distance.” Television, air-conditioners, and other common appliances at home use a remote so that people can operate them even from a distance. It is usually accompanied by the word control
