### Vocabulary:

anticipation (noun)

– the fact of seeing that something might happen in the future and perhaps doing something about it now

**Example:** We brought an umbrella for our walk in anticipation of the rain.

print (noun)

– (in this case) a mark made by pressure

**Example:** Two sets of prints were clearly visible in the snow.

boundary (noun)

– a real or imagined line that marks the limits or edges of something and separates it from other things or places; a dividing line

**Example:** Great artists always strive to push the boundaries of convention.

selectee (noun)

– a person who is chosen for something

**Example:** He was one of the selectees in the study.
