The Biggest Lake in the World

The biggest lake in the world is the Caspian Sea. It has a surface area of 371,000 square kilometers. The Caspian Sea is salty, about 1/3 as salty as the seawater.

The Largest Desert in the World

The largest desert in the world is Antarctica. Antarctica covers about 14 million square kilometers. Although it is cold, it is actually considered a desert because it gets very little precipitation each year.

The Hottest Desert in the World

The hottest desert in the world is the Sahara Desert. In 1922, scientists recorded a record high temperature of 58 °C. Though it's hot during the day, it sometimes freezes at night.

The Driest Desert in the World

The Atacama desert is the driest desert in the world. It receives just 1 mm of rain per year. Some places haven't had any rain in over 100 years.
