The Leaning Tower of Pisa

The Leaning Tower of Pisa was originally built as a bell tower but today is one of the most popular tourist attractions in Italy. It was constructed from 1117 to 1370 and leans because the foundation it lies on is unstable subsoil made up of a combination of sand, clay and water. Leaning 14,5 feet out of line from the top, the tower is part of a complex of three buildings, a bapistrey, a church and a bell tower. Together the three form the Cathedral of Pisa. The Tower was built during the Romanesque period and is therefore known for it's colorful marble and arches. According to legend, Italian physicist Galileo made some of his famous experiments with falling weights in 1589 from the top of the tipped tower.
