According to Parry Aftab of the U.S. Wired Safety Group, cyberbullying occurs “when a child is tormented, harassed, humiliated, embarrassed by another child using the Internet, interactive and digital technologies or mobile phones.”

In a European study on Internet safety that included the Czech Republic, Estonia, Lithuania, and Romania, students mentioned many forms of cyberbullying. Among them were “mockery, ‘leg pulling,’ insults, threats, disagreeable comments and slander, sent by e-mail, put forward on discussion forums, left on blogs, telephoned anonymously or sent by text message.”
