

First Freight Train From China to Britain Arrives in London

Vocabulary:

freight (noun)

– goods that are transported by ships, planes, trains or lorries/trucks

Example: They are taking the freight off the boats with a crane.

milestone (noun)

– a very important stage or event in the development of something

Example: This product is an important milestone in our company's history.

wholesale (adjective)

– connected with goods that are bought and sold in large quantities, especially so they can be sold again to make a profit

Example: If the wholesale price of oil rises, all energy costs also rise.

consignment (noun)

– a quantity of goods that are sent or delivered somewhere

Example: The consignment of new office equipment has arrived.

commodity (noun)

– a product or a raw material that can be bought and sold

Example: Rice is an important commodity in Asia.
