-an example that is used to justify similar occurrences at a later time **Example**: The American legal system is based on a study of precedent.

malicious

Malicious is the adjective based on the noun malice, which means the desire to harm others.

Example: Her actions had no malicious intent.

Forget the chocolates, roses and jewelry. This Valentine's Day (Feb. 14), perhaps the best gift we can give our significant other is our undivided attention. A recent international survey of more than 13,000 adults found that in the company of their partner, nearly 40 percent felt their partner paid more attention to their mobile device.

The survey was commissioned by Intel Security and analyzed how romantic relationships are affected by online behavior. New relationships were included in the analysis, with 33 percent of respondents indicating that they have had to compete against a mobile device for their partner's attention on a first date.
