

Halloween Treat: A Night at Dracula's Castle in Transylvania

Vocabulary:

stake (noun)

– a wooden or metal post that is pointed at one end and pushed into the ground in order to support something, mark a particular place, etc.

Example: Tomato plants are usually tied to stakes so they don't fall over.

impale (verb)

– to push a sharp pointed object through something

Example: She impaled the piece of meat with her fork.

ward off (phrasal verb)

– to protect or defend yourself against danger, illness, attack, etc.

Example: The politician has a distinct talent to ward off any criticism.

incursion (noun)

– a sudden attack on a place by foreign armies, etc.

Example: The rebels made an incursion into an area controlled by government forces.

reputedly (adverb)

– used to say that something is generally thought to be true, although this is not certain

Example: This is reputedly the best restaurant in town.
