**Example:** They agreed to the deal.

**owe** - to have to pay somebody for something that you have already received or return money that you have borrowed

**Example:** The amount owed is at the bottom of the bill.

**demand** - to ask for something very firmly

**Example:** Our boss demanded that we finish our work more quickly.
