Countable Nouns

- \rightarrow refer to things that can be counted.
- E.g 1. Rohan has two bags.
 - 2. I have five pencils.

Uncountable Nouns

- → refer to things that cannot be counted
- → thay are always singular in form.
- E.g 1. I like sugar.
 - 2. He has little milk.
- ?: Can you count sugar and milk? NO

2. Singular and Plural

- a. Singular Noun
 - \rightarrow refers to one person or one thing.
- **E.g** 1. A boy
 - 2. A leaf
 - 3. A pen
