1. at

e.g

- a. Sunrise is at five a.m.
- b. I eat lunch at one p.m.

2. on

 \rightarrow for things that happen on set dates or days.

e.g

- a. New Year's day is celebrated on January 1.
- b. Filipino people celebrate Independence day on June 12.

Please give me an example using on:

3. in

- → when talking about the things that happen within a month or a year.
- → things that happen within a month or a year.

e.g

- a. I came in U.K in 2001.
- b. My birthday is in September.
