Pronunciation of -S, -ES:

1. To make a noun plural, a final -s or -es is added to the noun:

```
Noun + s
e.g friend → friends
Noun + es
e.g glass → glasses
```

- 2. A final -s or -es is added to a present tense verb when the subject is a singular noun,
 - e.g. my father works at a bank. (My father is a singular noun)

>Verb + s
e.g work
$$\rightarrow$$
 works
>Verb + es
e.g watch \rightarrow watches

Spelling: Final -s / -es

•Most words (verbs & nouns), add a final –s,

e.g.
$$sing \rightarrow sings;$$

 $song \rightarrow songs$
