Vocabulary:

prone(adjective) - likely to suffer from something or to do something bad **Example:** If you look closely at this player's career, you will see that he is quite prone to injury.

spacious (adjective) – large and with plenty of space for people to move around in **Example**: They have bought a spacious, new apartment.

spare (adjective) – kept in case you need to replace the one you usually use; extra **Example**:Do you have a spare key? I lost mine.

patch(noun) – a small piece of material that is used to cover a hole in something or to make a weak area stronger, or as decoration; fast, temporary fixExample: I asked the mechanic to put a patch on the tire, because I didn't have enough money to buy a new one.

replica (noun) – a very good or exact copy of something **Example:** I brought her a small replica of the Sydney Opera House from my trip to Australia.
