## Robber with perfect manners



Good manners cost nothing as the saying goes, in fact they netted Gregory Hess \$3000 and the title of the World's Politest Armed Robber. The strange robbery scene was captured on the petrol station's CCTV footage and has been posted on the internet - giving Hess a cult following and the police hard evidence which led to Mr Hess's arrest the following Monday.
