Vocabulary:

hectic (adjective)

– very busy; full of activity

Example: We couldn't meet yesterday. She has a very hectic schedule.

snarl (in this case – noun)

– a tangled or congested situation

Example: I was late to work because of a traffic snarl.

errand (noun)

– a job that you do for somebody that involves going somewhere to take a message, to buy something, deliver goods, etc.

Example: My boss sent me on an errand this morning.

congestion (noun)

– the state of being crowded and full of traffic

Example: Traffic congestion and pollution are two of the big problems modern cities face.

stroller (noun)

– a small folding seat on wheels in which a small child sits and is pushed along

Example: They bought a very expensive stroller for their baby girl.
