To Tattoo or Not to Tattoo



A person's beliefs are not always as permanent as their religious tattoos either. In some countries, young people require parental permission to get a tattoo. Youth don't always consider the consequences of tattooing. Would you hire someone with a large tattoo? Would you marry someone with a tattoo? What if the tattoo was of an ex-girlfriend or boyfriend? Some people prefer discreet tattoos on an ankle or hip. Others plaster their entire bodies with tattoos. People even get tattoos on their faces
