Vocabulary:

decline (noun)

– a continuous decrease in the number, value, quality, etc. of something

Example: If you look at the graph, you will notice a steady decline in sales.

vanish (verb)

– to stop existing

Example: Her village has vanished during the war.

snapshot (noun)

– a short description or a small amount of information that gives you an idea of what something is like

Example: The novel offers a snapshot about life in 19th century Britain.

survey (noun)

– an investigation of the opinions, behaviour, etc. of a particular group of people, which is usually done by asking them questions

Example: The survey showed that most men prefer drinking beer rather than wine.
