TENSES of VERBS

VERBS

- \rightarrow are words or group of words that refer to actions and states.
- → are sometimes known as action words.

E.g The girl is **singing.** Let's **play** soccer.

Primary Verbs:

 \rightarrow do, have, and do.

VERB forms:

1. Present

- → the most basic tense in English and uses the base form of the verb
- \rightarrow exist at the present time
- → to express habits and general truths.

e.g

walk, go, eat, dance, sing, play, study

Sentence:

They walk home.

She can dance.

Let's eat.

I can sing.

They play soccer.

I study Math.

2. Past

- $a. \rightarrow$ action is done or finish
 - \rightarrow add -ed to form the past tense(regular verbs)

e.g

dance + ed = danced

play + ed = played

finish + ed = finished

walk + ed = walked

note + ed = noted

Sentence:

I danced at the party last night.

My brother played soccer at the gym.

I finished my homeworks.

We walked to the grcoery.

She noted my absences.

b. \rightarrow words are changed to form past tense of the verb(irregular verbs)
